SLAV Research Fellowship Award

This research fellowship will take the form of a \$1000 grant to provide practical support to a Teacher librarian or a Library team members to implement a local research project.

Criteria

- the research project should add to the body of evidence regarding the impact that the teacher-librarian or library team has on student learning,
- the research grant will support a research project currently underway or planned to commence in 2013.

Applications should include a research proposal (3 pages maximum) detailing:

- topic of research,
- rationale,
- objective/s,
- timeline and budget,
- research process/methodology.

Individual or team applications will be considered.

Please note: The recipient/s of this grant will be required to publish a report on the research and its findings in a SLAV journal, FYI or Synergy, and/or make a presentation at a SLAV conference/workshop
