

SLAV Awards SLAV School Leader's Award

The SLAV School Leader's Award is made to a school leader who demonstrates outstanding support of the school library and the work of the school library team. The award recipient will be recognised at a presentation at the School Library Association of Victoria Conference at the State Library of Victoria on November 25th 2016.

School leaders can be nominated by a school library team member (SLAV membership required). Any school personnel who are members of the school leadership team within the school are eligible to be nominated.

Award criteria

Outstanding support of the school library may be demonstrated by:

- recognition and articulation of the role of the library as integral to the learning and teaching program of the school.
- innovative support of a new learning program or approach undertaken by the library team,
- support for increased resources in recognition of the valuable role that the school library plays in the learning and teaching of the school,
- active and visionary championing of the need for an effective school library program.

Nomination guidelines

Nominations should include:

- a brief statement (approximately one page) describing the supportive actions of the nominee,
- documentation/evidence of specific examples of activities which support one or more of the above criteria.
