SLAV Research Fellowship

This research fellowship will take the form of a \$1000 grant to provide practical support to a teacher-librarian or a library team member/s to implement a local research project. The recipient will also receive one free registration to an event in the following year.

Award criteria

- the research project should add to the body of evidence regarding the impact that the teacher-librarian or library team has on student learning,
- the research grant will support a research project currently underway or planned to commence in the following year.

Applications should include a research proposal (3 pages maximum) detailing

- topic of research,
- rationale,
- objective/s,
- timeline and budget,
- research process/methodology.

Individual or team applications will be considered.

Please note: The recipient/s of this award will be required to publish a report in a SLAV journal, *FYI* or *Synergy*, and/or make a presentation at a SLAV professional learning activity.
