This SLAV award takes the form of a \$1000 professional development grant and free registration at two SLAV events in the following year. The award is made to a teacher-librarian in recognition of an outstanding contribution to the profession of teacher-librarianship.

Award criteria

Applicants should demonstrate:

- an outstanding contribution to teaching and learning at their school,
- the raised profile of the profession as a result of their activities as a teacher-librarian, and
- active involvement as a member of the School Library Association of Victoria.

Documentation

Applicants are requested to

- document specific examples of activities which support the above criteria, and
- supply supporting evidence (via attachments where necessary).

Please note: The recipient/s of this award will be required to publish a report in a SLAV journal, FYI or Synergy, and/or make a presentation at a SLAV professional learning activity.
